## Dot Foods Donates Truckload to Area Food Bank

Food redistributor celebrates its 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary with a donation to Gleaners Food Bank of Indiana



CAMBRIDGE CITY, Ind. – Dot Foods recently loaded its 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary commemorative golden trailer and donated a truckload of dry foods and goods to Gleaners Food Bank of Indiana. The donation, delivered on Friday, June 11, marked the second stop for the trailer on its nationwide tour.
