Communication Methods

Dot Foods supports several communication methods such as traditional Value Added Networks (VANs), AS2, FTP, and Secure FTP. The supplier should consult with their Dot EC Coordinator to determine which method makes the most sense for both companies.

Third Party Providers

If the supplier is not currently EDI capable but would like to pursue an EDI relationship with Dot Foods, the Dot EC Coordinator can provide a list of 3rd party providers. The supplier can then research these providers to determine whether one of these companies will meet their EDI needs.

997 Functional Acknowledgments

997 Functional Acknowledgments are requested for each outbound document generated by Dot Foods and should be sent within 24 hours of receiving the original document. Outbound acknowledgments will likewise be generated by Dot Foods and sent within 24 hours of Dot Foods' receipt of inbound documents.

Item Identifiers

Dot Foods is capable of sending the 14 digit GTIN, 12 digit UPC, the supplier's internal product number, and the Dot item number on most outbound documents. The supplier must be capable of sending the 14 digit GTIN or 12 digit UPC on their outbound documents as these are the only item identifiers that Dot processes. It is strongly recommended that suppliers send 14 digit GTIN's on their outbound EDI documents; however, we will accept the 12 digit UPC if GTIN's are not supported.

Testing Protocol

Dot Foods employs a three phase testing process for new trading partner implementations.

Initial Testing

During the initial testing phase, both parties will be testing connectivity and verifying data structure. Data exchanged during this phase does not have to be production data; however, it should be representative of the live data which will follow during the parallel testing phase.

Inbound to Dot

It is recommended that the trading partner send test EDI documents to Dot Foods with the ISA15 set to "T" for Test. It is requested that the partner notify the Dot EC Coordinator prior to sending the test data.

Upon receipt of a test inbound EDI document, the Dot EC Coordinator will compare the test document to our EDI specifications to ensure that all required segments/elements have been sent. If not, the EC Coordinator will request that the trading partner correct and resend the test document until the format has been approved.

Outbound to Trading Partner

Dot Foods will send all test EDI documents with a "T" in the ISA15 unless notified otherwise by the trading partner.

Dot Foods will send examples of each outbound transaction set to the trading partner via EDI. Sample data may also be sent via e-mail upon request.

Parallel Testing

In the second phase, data should be sent with the ISA15 marked as "P" for production. Data traded by both parties is production data which should exactly mirror the paper documents distributed during the same time frame. Data content is validated by various user departments for accuracy and is updated into production systems. It is imperative that the trading partner continues to send paper transactions without interruption during the parallel phase.

The parallel phase is in effect for 30 days; however, it may be extended if either party encounters any issues while processing the EDI data. Once the appropriate user departments for both companies have determined that the EDI data matches the paper documents and is processing correctly, then the parties will move to the production phase.

Production

The Production phase continues indefinitely. Paper documents are only exchanged upon special request. Any problems that occur should be communicated to the appropriate Dot EC Coordinator immediately.
